

6. **Round 6:** Chain 2, *dc in the next dc, chain 2, 3 dc in the next chain-2 space, chain 2, dc in the next 3 dc*. Repeat from * to * around. Sl st to the top of the first dc to close the round.
7. **Round 7:** Chain 2, *dc in the next dc, chain 2, 3 dc in the next chain-2 space, chain 2, dc in the next 4 dc*. Repeat from * to * around. Sl st to the top of the first dc to close the round.
8. **Round 8:** Chain 2, *dc in the next dc, chain 2, 3 dc in the next chain-2 space, chain 2, dc in the next 5 dc*. Repeat from * to * around. Sl st to the top of the first dc to close the round.
9. **Round 9:** Chain 2, *dc in the next dc, chain 2, 3 dc in the next chain-2 space, chain 2, dc in the next 6 dc*. Repeat from * to * around. Sl st to the top of the first dc to close the round.

Continue crocheting granny squares until you have the desired number for your afghan.
