- Separate a single strand from the 6-strand embroidery floss.
- Thread the needle with the single strand, leaving a tail of about 4 inches.

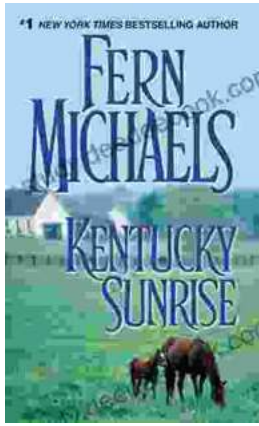
