
Fundamental Otology: Comprehensive Pediatric and Adult Practice

Adult Otology


Adult otology is the branch of otology that deals with the diagnosis and treatment of ear disorders in adults. Adults are susceptible to a variety of ear disorders, including:

* Hearing loss * Tinnitus * Vertigo * Ménière's disease * Otosclerosis


Otologists who specialize in adult otology are trained to diagnose and treat these disorders and other ear problems in adults. They may also perform a variety of surgical procedures on adults, including:
