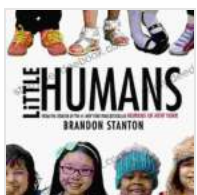


# Little Humans: A Photographic Journey into the Lives of Children Around the World

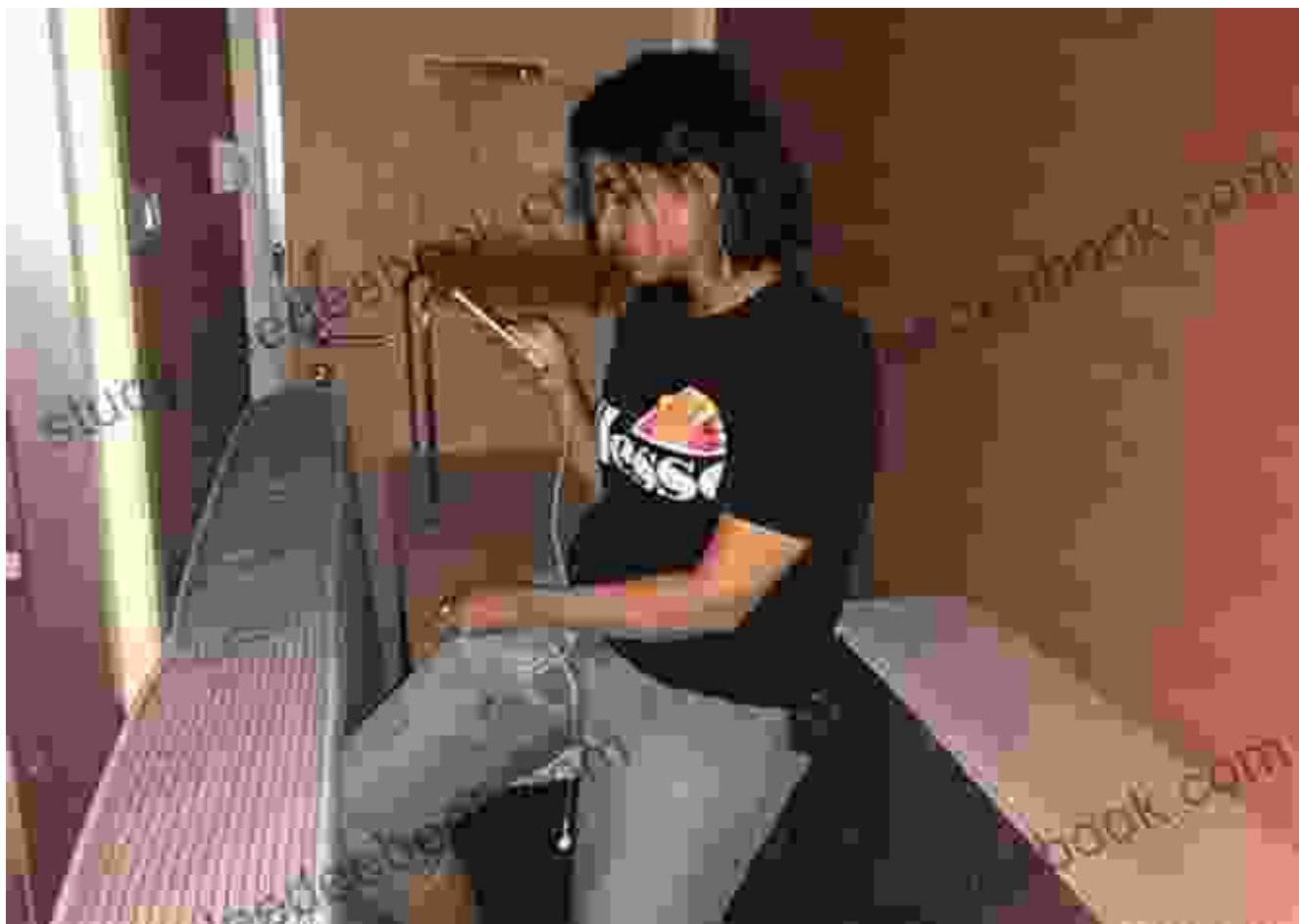

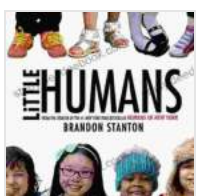
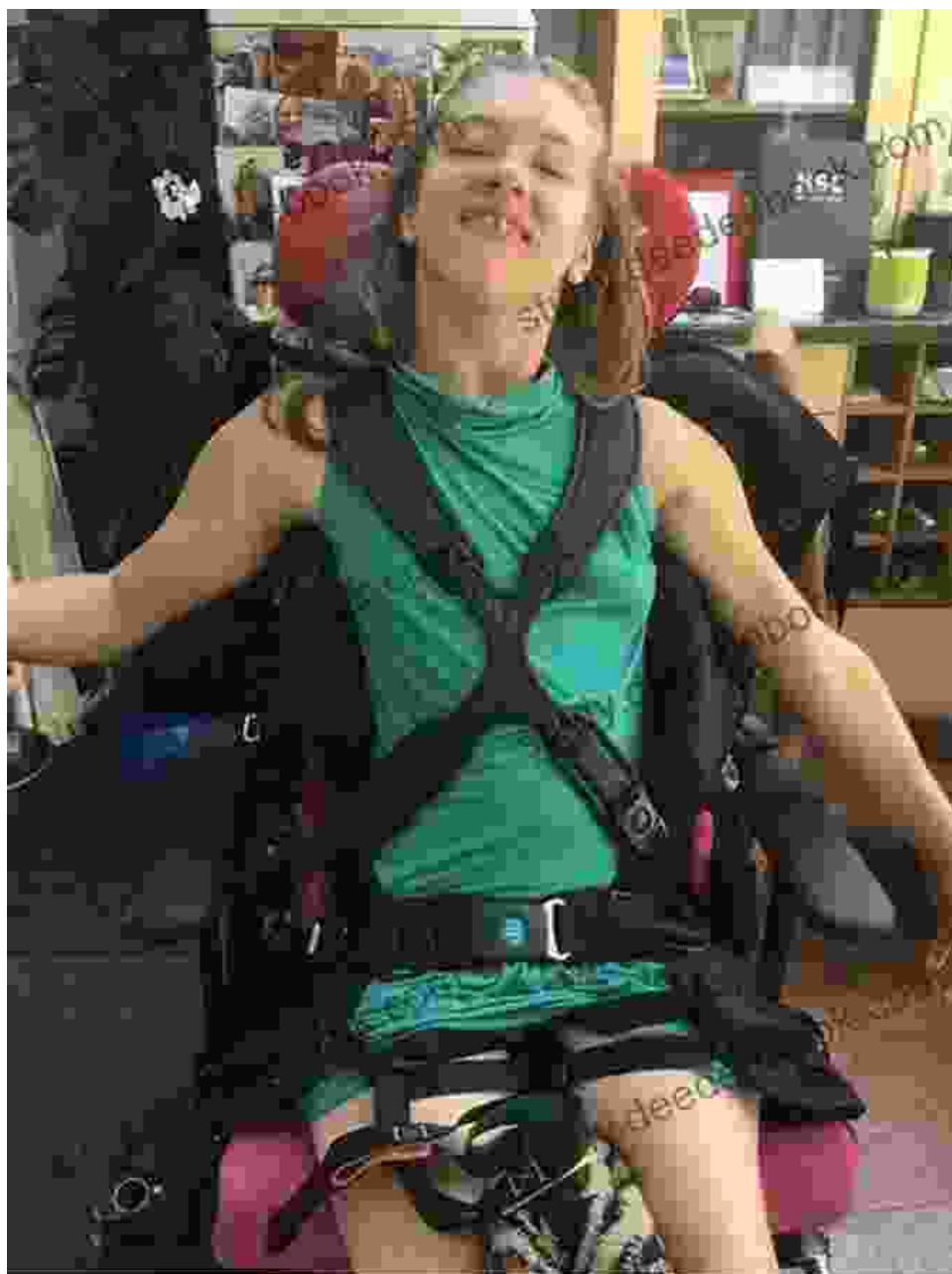
