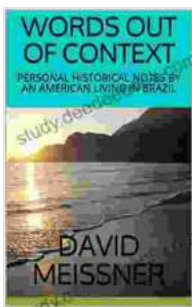


Personal Historical Notes By An American Living In Brazil: A Journey of Cultural Immersion and Personal Transformation

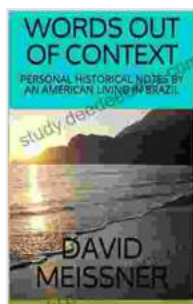
